The arrival of MS Statendam

The MS Statendam Cruise Ship, a Holland America Line, arrived at the Apia wharf in the early hours of Tuesday, 17 October 2006, carrying 1218 passengers and 579 crew. The ship arrived from Kona Hawaii via Pago Pago American Samoa.

Quarantine carried out the official clearance on arrival. All the people on board were advised NOT to take ashore any Quarantine Risk Items that may threaten Samoa's Biodiversity/Agriculture.

The ship left Samoa at about 6pm in the evening.
