



Cane Toad is now a top pest to be looked out for in the country. Nine cases have been reported this year from Tuanaimato, Tuaefu, Siusega, Pesega, Lotopa, Samoa College, Matautu, Vaiala and recently, 30<sup>th</sup> November 2007 at Faleasi'u. The case was immediately attended by Quarantine Officers in which they carried out a surveillance around the area and so far nothing else has been found. Public consultations have been carried out with the village mayor, families and the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (MNRE).

Cane Toad lives in different habitats and it is a threat to drinking water. We should be diligently watching out for this pest and we urge for public support to report this pest when seen or heard to Quarantine Office at Tel: 20924.
